- RBWA New Waterfowler Program - Friday Evening, Sept 14, 2018
- RBWA Mentored Youth Hunt - Saturday, Sept 15, 2018. (2018 Heritage Hunt)

The New Waterfowler Program on Friday Evening, Sept 14, 2018

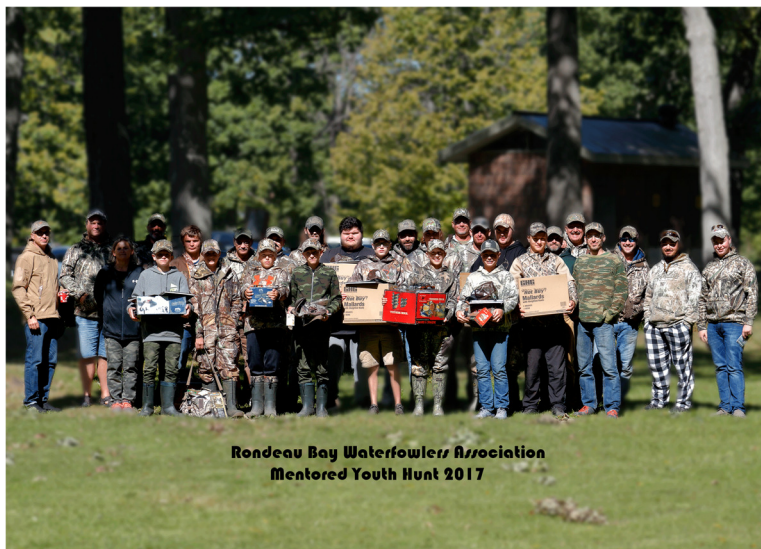


- Begins at 6:00 pm
- Open to all waterfowlers
- Cost: FREE!
- Food, and entrance into the Park provided by RBWA
- A program of waterfowl instruction will be presented by local, experienced, waterfowlers.
- Equipment draws which include **thousands of dollars in prizes, a draw for a new shotgun, and the Jacob Suitor Package for a new hunter** are open to all waterfowlers **12 to 17 years of age**
- As well, draws for A Zone blinds for Heritage Day will be held. Any blinds not taken in the draw will be available as Heritage Hunt blinds on Saturday at 5:00 am.
- Limited RBWA Mentors will be available for those who

wish to make use of them. To access RBWA mentors, a participating hunter must sign up by **Sept 1, 2018**.

- Otherwise, young hunters may participate in the Heritage Hunt with a mentor of their own choosing
- Blinds will be chosen using our regular draw system - without reservations.



The RBWA Mentored Youth Hunt Sept 15, 2018

- The Mentored Youth Hunt 2018 is open to any hunter under the age of 18.
- Participants must follow the regulations laid out under the Heritage guidelines: **only qualified hunters between the ages of 12-17 may hunt.** (Mentors are not allowed to hunt.)
- Participants in the Youth Hunt may camp at Rondeau Park free on Friday night.
- Participants may hunt until legal closing time if they and their mentor wish
- As the RBWA "A Zone Opening Day Draw" is at 2:00 pm Saturday afternoon, some mentors may choose to end the day by 11:00.
